Degree Programs

At NKU Chase, we believe that you should have every opportunity to attend law school on a schedule that works for you. All divisions require 90 total credit hours to graduate.

Full-Time Division

- The full-time division is geared toward individuals who can commit to the full-time study of law.
- 15 credit hours per semester, summer semesters optional.
 - Classes typically meet five days per week in the first year.

Part-Time Division

The part-time divisions can be completed in four years, if students attend year-round, summers included.

Daytime

- 9-10 credit hours per semester.
- Summer semesters optional.
- Classes typically meet three days per week between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Evening

- 9-10 credit hours per semester.
- Summer semesters required.
- Classes typically meet three nights per week 6:30-9:15 p.m.

Joint Degrees

JD/MBA (Master of Business Administration)

- Available for both full- and part-time study.
- Joint degrees are completed in 108 credit hours.
- Must apply and be accepted to both Chase College of Law and Haile/US Bank College of Business.

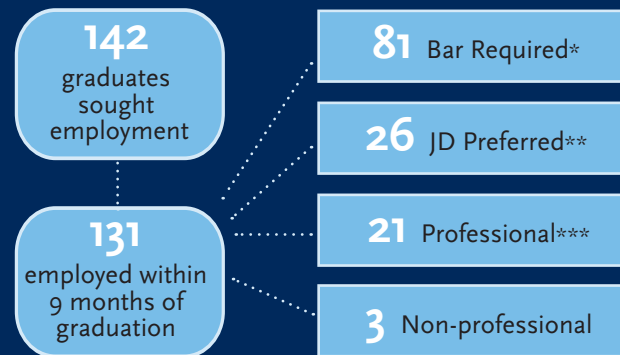

Of the 149 total graduates, 144 provided employment data. Two graduates were not seeking employment.

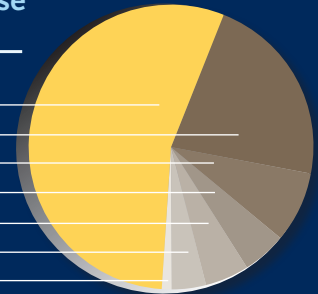
*Bar admission-required jobs are traditionally practicing attorney positions.
