

V. EMPLOYMENT DURING LAW SCHOOL

The American Bar Association, which establishes standards for accreditation of law schools, mandates that a **student may not work for pay for more than 20 hours per week during any week in which the student is enrolled in more than 12 class-hours.** Employment in excess of 20 hours per week is permitted for part-time students and for all students during summer months, unless enrolled in more than 12 class-hours. NKU Chase College of Law expects all students to comply with this standard. A student who violates this standard is subject to dismissal from the College of Law.

All students (full-time and part-time) will use *Digital Measures Student Activity Insight* to report their employment data for each semester (fall, spring, and summer). This information will also be discussed during the Career Development Center orientation sessions held each November for first-year students, and will be the subject of communications from the Career Development office.
