Restorative Justice and the Environment II

- EJ and Natural Resources (Eds. Mutz, Bryner, Kenney)
 - Distributive Justice and Ethics
 - How do we distribute benefits and burdens equitably; how do we compensate for past injustices?
 - Social Justice
 - How do we address the interaction of economic, political, and social factors to address root causes of injustice?



Restorative Justice and the Environment III

- Restorative Justice: "to repair harm to the victim, address the root cause of the crime [injustice], and ideally, transform unjust systems and structures in order to reduce or prevent future crime [injustice]."
- Easy to think about with a polluter.
- What if the cause of harm is the law itself? Is changing the law enough?






Infrastructure, Governance, Culture

- Water sharing on and between acequias




The Origin of Acequias






The Mexican-American War

 - Promises to respect Mexican property rights

Colorado

- Explicit discrimination in the legislature.
- Failure to recognize acequias until 2009 Acequia Recognition Act and 2012 amendment.
- 133 years under the radar.

By the Numbers

- Founded: 2012
- Students Attorneys: ~ 60-90 each year (new and returning)
- Pro Bono Supervising Attorneys: 15
- New cases per year: ~ 10
 - Filing for water rights
 - Writing by-laws
 - Title search and opinion
 - Public research and white papers
- Average value of legal services provided per year: \$300,000
- ABA Awards: 1
