Stonewall Uprising (Riots): Widely considered watershed event that transformed the gay liberation movement/Twentieth Century fight for LGBTQ+ rights


June 28, 1970 – "Christopher Street March" to mark the first anniversary; now annual Pride celebrations internationally

Anita Bryant – Save Our Children, 1977



- Gays & Lesbians recruited and threatened children: "[They] cannot reproduce, so they must recruit. And to freshen their ranks, they must recruit the youth of America."
- Her core argument: Gay people were evil & didn't deserve rights. "If we label homosexuality a civil rights issue, what is to stop the murderer from shouting 'murderer rights'"?
- Dade County ordinance was repealed, but opposition to the bill led to a kind of new LGBTQ activism.




Bowers v. Hardwick, 5-4, 6/30/86

GA Law: Up to 20 years for a single, private, adult consensual intimate act.

Issue: "Whether the Constitution confers a fundamental right upon homosexuals to engage in sodomy."

Holding: No. Majority opinion compared same-sex intimacy with adultery, incest & other sexual crimes & found protecting homosexual sodomy as a fundamental right would "cast aside millennia of moral teaching."

Impact? Criminals; Custody, Discrimination



Lawrence v. Texas, 6-3 June 26, 2003







Bowers was not correct when it was decided, and it is not correct today. It ought not to remain binding precedent. Bowers v. Hardwick should be and now is overruled."

Marriage in the States

- 2003: Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court ruled in *Goodridge v. Department of Public Health* that it was unconstitutional under MA's Constitution to abridge marriage on the basis of sex.
- From 2004 to 6/26/15: Various state court rulings, state legislation, direct popular votes& federal court rulings established same-sex marriage in thirty-six of the fifty states plus D.C.



United States v. Windsor June 26, 2013
